Our musician this year will be Ken Martlew (piano).

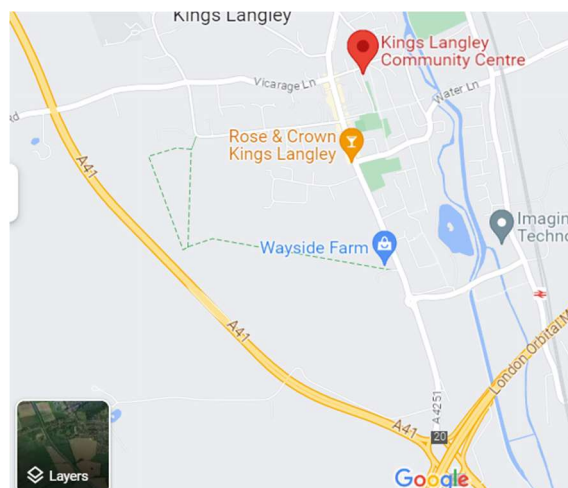
Please forward this email to others who you think might be willing to assist and ask for it to go onto your club’s website diary page.

Both the mock and the main exams will be held, as before, in Kings Langley Community Centre, just north of Watford, Hertfordshire WD4 8ET

There are good Rail links from Euston to Kings Langley (the hall is then a 15-minute walk); the M25 J20 and A41 junction is approximately 1 mile from the hall which has free parking.



Frequently Asked Questions: .

1. Sessions start throughout the day, the main start times being approximately 9am-1pm and 2-5pm.
2. If you cannot do a full session your help will still be appreciated, if we get enough volunteers, we like to swap them round so that the later candidates don't get exhausted volunteers, obviously this is more important on 21st June.
3. The candidates' "classes" are each approximately 30/40 minutes long. We will be doing sessions of 2 or 3 candidates together with a warm up beforehand. So yes, 1 ½/2 hours is a good time to attend.
4. The hall is large and airy with air conditioning and there will be very good space between the sets. We require 16 or 18 dancers per class.
5. Tea, coffee and biscuits will be provided during the day, but you should bring your own lunch/snacks.
6. When not required for dancing, there is an adjoining hall for refreshments and relaxing as well as outdoors if the weather permits.
7. The exact timetable will not be known until 2 days before the exams as the timings will be dependant which steps/formations and dances the examiners require to be taught.
