
## **CAIRNCROSS**

Strathspey for Five couples in a Longways Set Tune: The Thistle of Scotland (Trad.)

## Diag.1



- 1 4 First and fifth couples (end couples) cross, giving right hands and cast, first couple down while second couple steps up and fifth couple up while fourth couple steps down. Places as in diag.1
- 5 8 First and second ladies give right hands to start a half ladies' chain, while fifth and fourth men do the same for a half men's chain
- 9 -12 Second and first, fifth and fourth couples dance half rights and lefts
- 12-20 Repeat bars 5-12. Places as in diag.1
- 21-24 First and fifth couples cross giving right hands and cast to original places, second and fourth step down or up
- 25-28 First and second, third and fourth couples dance a half poussette
- 29-32 First and forth, third and fifth couples dance a half poussette. See note. Repeat from new places

NOTE: on poussettes - start from side lines

- 25 1st & 2nd, 3rd & 4th couples in to meet
- 26 Dance diagonally outward-
- 27 Dance diagonally into the middle
- 28 Turn to own side of dance and the 5th couple dance in to meet
- 29 2nd couple falls back to the side while others dance diagonally outward-
- 30 Dance diagonally into the middle
- 31 Turn to own side of dance
- 32 Fall back to the line of dance
