
A LOBSTER IN THE POT

A Two Couple Jig

A children's dance, can be danced in a four couple set or as a round the room dance.

Tune: Laird o' Cockpen (Trad)



- 1 3 First couple dance down the middle for three skip change.
- 4 First man swings his partner round in front of him (diag.1)
- 5 7 and they both dance back up the set for three skip change, lady on the man's left side
- 8 Second man places right hand on hip so that first lady can link her left arm with him. Second lady does the same with left arm.

First couple link second couple and swing round them.

First couple finish in second place on the wrong side and second couple in first place (diag.2)

- 9 -16 First and second couples rights and lefts
- 17-24 First and second couples Ladies' Chain
- 25-26 First couple set
- 27-28 First couple do four spring points
- 29-30 First couple set
- 31-32 First couple cross to own side giving right hands.

Repeat from new places.

THE TALE:

- 1 6 The Lobster explores
- 7 8 The Lobster enters the pot.
- 9 -16 The Pot,
- 17-24 The Lobster tries to get out
- 25-32 The Fisherman celebrates
