

Jig. Four Couple Longways Set

Tune: Glendaruel Highlanders (Kerr's Collection)

Two chords to start, on the second, first lady crosses to right hand side of her partner, second man crosses to his partner's place and she moves up to top place; while third and fourth couples do the same.



- ${\bf 1}$ ${\bf 4}$ First and second couples advance and retire towards each other across the dance while third and fourth couples do the same.
- 5 8 All advance again and pass giving right hands to opposite, turn partner left hands. Finish first couple facing third couple and second couple facing fourth couple in lines across the dance. (diag.1)
- 9 -16 Repeat bars 1-8 advancing up and down the dance, finish in original lines, first couple have changed places with fourth couple, second couple have changed places with third couple. (Places as at diag. 2)
- 17-24 First and second couples, third and fourth couples, four hands across and back.
- 25-32 Second and third couples diagonal reels of four, left shoulder start with partner. Ladies pass right shoulders in the middle. (diag. 2)
- 33-40 First and fourth couples Ladies' chain. Ladies give right hands to start.
- 41-44 Third with fourth couple and first with second couple half rights and lefts.
- 45-48 Second and third couples half diagonal reel of four to change places. Ladies give right shoulders in middle of dance. All couples finish one place, anticlockwise round dance.

Repeat from new places.
