
My Mither's Aye Glow'rin' Owre Me

32 bar Jig

Music: My mither's aye glow'rin' owre me & My wife is a winsome wee thing arranged by Peter White (see Dances to Song Tunes for the music).



- 1-4 1st and 2nd couples, taking hands at the sides, advance and retire, and
- 5-8 Dance half rights and lefts.
- 9-10 1st and 2nd couples, taking hands at the sides set to partners.
- 11-14 1st couple cast up and cross to own sides, while 2nd turn by the right hand once round to 2nd place, "wrong" sides (see figure 1).
- 15-16 1st and 2nd couples again set to partners.
- 17-20 1st couple approach each other, turn away and cast off one place.
- 21-24 Turn by the right hand once round and cast up to top place.
- 25-28 Cross to below 2nd couple and cast up to top place (see figure 2).
- $29\mbox{-}32$ 1st and 2nd couples dance half rights and lefts.

Repeat, having passed a couple.
