

## WAITING FOR JOYCE

A Jig for Four Couples in a Longways Set  
Tune: Joyce's Jig (M. Rimmer)

1 - 2 First couple set

3 - 4 First couple petronella into the centre of the set

5 - 6 First couple set and man turns about to face down

7 - 8 First man followed by partner dances down the set

9 -16 First man dances a diagonal reel of three giving right shoulders to fourth man to start and with third lady, while first lady dances a diagonal reel of three giving right shoulder to third man to start and with second lady

17-24 First man dances a diagonal reel of three giving right shoulder to third man to start and with fourth lady, while first lady dances a diagonal reel of three giving right shoulder to second man to start and with third lady

25-28 First man dances out between third man and fourth man and casts down while first lady dances out between second man and third man and casts down

27-32 First couple meet in the middle of the set and turn with the right hand to fourth place while second, third and fourth give hands and step up on 27-28.

Repeat with second couple starting
